**Here are our Compost Guidelines. We appreciate your support!**

**YES:**

- ✓ Food scraps/leftovers
- ✓ Fruit and vegetable trimmings
- ✓ Meats, bones, dairy/oils (not more than 10% of container contents)
- ✓ Breads, cereals, grains, rice
- ✓ Nuts
- ✓ Egg shells
- ✓ Coffee grounds and paper coffee filters
- ✓ Natural fiber tea bags (remove staple if present)
- ✓ Plant trimmings from organic gardens that haven't had chemicals used on them.
- ✓ Non-bleached/inked napkins and paper towels as long as they are soiled with only organic material (no oily shop towels for instance)
- ✓ Cardboard substantially soiled by food like pizza. If clean, please recycle. Please tear into small pieces and remove any non-compostable items from within boxes.
- ✓ All to-go PLA (corn plastic) or paper containers and utensils specifically labeled as "compostable"

**NO:**

- × Trash or Recycling: clean cardboard, #1 and #2 plastics, glossy paper, aluminum foil and aluminum cans, etc.
- × Non-compostable Plastics. Thin-film plastics like plastic bags, clamshells, and other packaging.
- × Rubber Gloves
- × Fruit and vegetable stickers/tags/labels/rubber bands
- × Dryer lint (contains micro-plastics from synthetic fabrics)
- × Pet waste / hair
- × Ornamental Flowers (these are often sprayed with Herbicides and pesticides during growth, so they are considered contamination)
- × Yardwaste/grass clippings (lawns are so often treated with herbicides and pesticides that they are considered contamination and, if accepted, void any "organic" certification. I offer a separate yard waste collection that is composted in a different location from the food scraps)

**Collection dates for 2021 are every other Tuesday after 9 am:**
